- We are only selling the lot to you or your builder, and once the lot contract has been firmed, you will need to work with your builder directly during the home building process.
- Architectural design requirements will need to be adhered to. We will share our guidelines once you reach that stage.
- Permits and Regulations: Familiarize yourself with local building codes, zoning regulations, and permit requirements. Your builder should be well-versed in these as well. These lots will require a <u>Development Permit</u> to proceed.
- Familiarize yourself with the community you will be living in. For example, there is a Home Owners Association that you would be a part of.
